WEAR BLUE AND WHITE TO CHANGE LIVES

SUPPORTING CHILDREN WITH A DISABILITY

Lily is 12 and she loves playing powerchair football with Albion in the Community.

She has spina bifida, which means she is paralysed from the waist down, and she faces challenges many people her age never have to overcome.

After being introduced to AITC in 2019 Lily became a regular at our weekly session for people using a powerchair or wheelchair; she loves being part of a team, learning new skills, and making friends.

“There is nothing else locally that Lily can attend because of her disabilities, she loves playing football at AITC.” – Lily’s mum



HOW YOUR BLUE AND WHITE MAKES A DIFFERENCE

£30

could pay for a specialist football to help give a young person with a visual impairment the opportunity to play.



£50

could help pay for a child in need to access our football programmes, giving them the opportunity to get active and make new friends.



£100

could help support a young person to be mentored, giving them the chance to build a better future.



£300

could help a child attend our sessions for a whole year to build their confidence and learn new skills.
